*****VOLUNTEERS NEEDED*****

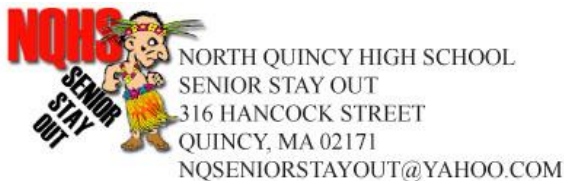
